Contest Rules

PUTTING

1. Entry incl. two putts from a designated location to a target hole.
2. The closest attempt will be the participant's entry.
3. When the ball comes to rest, the distance from the ball to the hole will be measured.
4. Top 5 closest participants (& ties) will advance to the final round.
5. Finalists will have one putt in the final round.
6. The closest putt to the hole is the winner.
7. In the event of a tie, all other participants are eliminated & the contest continues until there is a winner.

CHIPPING

1. Entry incl. two chips from a designated location to a target hole.
2. The closest attempt will be the participant's entry.
3. When the ball comes to rest, the distance from the ball to the hole will be measured.
4. Top 5 closest participants (& ties) will advance to the final round.
5. Finalists will have one chip in the final round.
6. The closest chip to the hole is the winner.
7. In the event of a tie, all other participants are eliminated & the contest continues until there is a winner.

CLOSEST TO THE PIN (KP)

1. Men & Women have separate contests on this shot.
2. The golfer whose tee shot comes to rest closest to the hole wins.
3. To win the competition, the ball must have stopped on the green. Any balls off the green are ignored, even if they are the closest.
4. No mulligan can be used in the contest.

LONGEST DRIVE

1. Men & Women have separate contests on this shot.
2. A golfer's shot must be in the fairway when it comes to rest to win.
3. If your shot comes to rest further than the mark, move the mark to your ball location & write your name.
4. No mulligan can be used in the contest.

STRAIGHTEST DRIVE

1. Must reach minimum drive line
2. If your drive qualifies, measure how far your ball is from the string line at a 90 degree angle.
3. Check leaderboard & fill in your name (with distance) if your drive is currently closest to the center line.
4. No mulligan can be used in the contest.

Golf Terms



SCRAMBLE

A best ball format where each player tees off and the team selects the best ball for their next shot. All other players pick up their ball and move it within one club length of the selected shot (no closer to the hole). All players then hit again, and the process continues until completion of the hole.

PAR

The number of strokes a team should make on a hole-- -- determined by the hole's difficulty and length.

BIRDIE

One shot below par.

EAGLE

Two shots below par.

BOGEY

One shot above par.

BOGEY IS MAX

MULLIGAN

A re-hit on your previous shot because you didn't like the outcome of the shot.

Mulligans can be purchased in a player package or individually during registration. Max of 3 per player. Mulligans cannot be used in contests.

FAIRWAY

The shorter-mown area of course between the tee box and the green.

GREEN

Where the hole and flag are located.

ROUGH

The longest grass that surrounds the fairway and green.

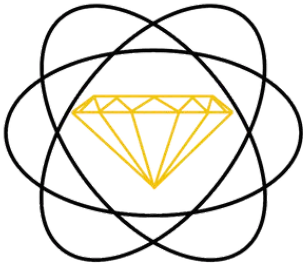
